### Texas Educators Vote Update

This week we are sending you some ideas and links to get more of your employees registered to vote. **It is not too late to register to vote for the May 24th runoff elections! The deadline to register for these elections is April 25th, which is just over two weeks away.**

There are several groups of people in your district who may not be registered to vote and could use a reminder and some information:

1. Anyone who has moved should update their information to be sure they are registered in their new address.

2. New employees and new teachers who have either moved from elsewhere, or have never been registered to vote.
