Texas primary day is next Tuesday, March 1st. We are excited to see the culture of voting that has been cultivated in districts across the state translate into active and engaged citizens next Tuesday. While there has been much attention to the presidential elections, there is relatively little fanfare about the races that determine our Texas legislators. These representatives and senators hold enormous power over education and these elections are of utmost importance to the health of our public schools. Texas legislators determine how and how much our schools are funded, how much we test our students and how high the stakes are, and whether to divert public funds to unaccountable private schools.

We urge you to remind your staff to vote and to be informed about the candidates and whether they will nurture public schools or hamper them.

This is such a great opportunity for students to learn about democracy and how it works, and to see their role models participate in their society by casting their important vote!

Thank you so much for supporting this culture shift. Let's move Texas up from 50th in voter participation through our actions today and next Tuesday!
