LAST CALL FOR VOTERS!

You can't vote if you aren't registered! The last day to register in Texas for the November 8th election is Tuesday, October 11th. Please remind your staff to check NOW and make sure they are registered, that their registration is up to date, and to register if they haven't already. It should be their number one priority this weekend!

Since we are so late in the process and the applications are due to the voter registrar's office by Tuesday, don't mail them in!
